

LEADERSHP

In 2012, GV served 490 Guatemalan and U.S. youth leaders who engaged in 83,000 hours of training and service.

40 GV Youth Board Leaders gave 13,000 hours to their local and international community.

GV served 167 U.S. youth from three states (WA, CO, CA) representing 20 high schools who worked side by side with 112 Guatemalan youth from five high schools. Both groups gained global leadership skills though year-long trainings and two-week cultural immersion experience in Guatemala.

SOCIAL JUSTICE

GV's Youth Board Pro-Justice Team initiated weekly meetings with key community, labor, and elected leaders advocating for social justice. They provided seven workshops to 110 first year participants, enabling them to become allies to those negatively impacted by racism, classism, sexism, and imperialism.

ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP

GV youth served 2,000 hours and completed the eighth season of reforestation in Guatemala, bringing the total number of native trees planted to 22,500; they served 1,600 hours in the Puget Sound at the Local Roots organic farm, protecting urban forests in Seattle through Earthcorps.
